Another suggestion: If it has rained, there may be water in the creek so it is a good idea to have a towel in your vehicle to dry off your dog for the trip home. If we have a good rain your dog may even go for a swim. Be prepared!

If you call, you should be prepared to provide the following information: name of the poison your animal was exposed to, the amount and how long ago; the species, breed, age, sex, and weight of your pet; and the symptoms the animal is displaying. You'll also be asked to provide your name, address phone number and credit card information.
