We are currently Fundraising for 2 very important construction projects.

1 - A shade structure designed and built to go over our newly constructed dog runs.

2 - A completely separate isolation building to house incoming dogs with no medical record. Both Parvo & Distemper are highly contagious life threatening deseases for dogs. We cannot risk bringing an infected dog into the general population so they must spend a few weeks in isolation.




Rudy & Teresa McIntyre Rudy was rescued from a bunch of dogs that were chasing him. The man was on his way to work and stopped by ARF.

Steven, still here that needs a home.




Purrcilla & Mark Westfall Purrcilla was brought in as a stray at an apartment complex during the cold winter.

Dog surgery includes rabies shot if needed >50 lbs - \$70 <50 lbs - \$60 Cat surgery includes rabies shot if needed
